03.

Increases exposure to natural light — a brightly lit space creates a more positive environment than a dimly lit one.

04.

Unblocks air vents or grilles.

05.

Ensures compliance with workplace and building smoking and scent policies.

01.

It just makes cents — carpooling can save you money by allowing you to share commuting costs.

02.

Avoid the Gridlock — one less car on the road is one less reason for traffic.

03.

Make new friends — and maybe, start your own version of carpool karaoke!

04

Be productive — get a head start on your emails or catch up on the news if you are not the one driving.

05.

If carpooling is not an option — see if public transit, walking, or biking, is a cheaper and more convenient option for your daily commute.

Make it A Walk to Remember



Did you know that going for walks can have a positive effect on stress reduction and mental health? If you are already on the *FitBit* trend, then boost your productivity and chase your goal of 10,000 steps by incorporating more walking in your daily life:

01.

Pace around when waiting for the microwave or kettle, or when you are on the phone.

02.

Walk the Talk by scheduling Walking Meetings — some research shows that walking leads to increases in creative thinking and can be more productive than traditional sit-down meetings.

03.

Use stairs in your building, and take the longer route, where possible.

04

Start a 'Walking Wednesdays' group — go on a mid-day walk with your co-workers and explore the neighbourhood near your office.

05.

Organize a 'Step Count Challenge' — track steps and award prizes for the top stepper, most improved, etc.

Walking briskly for just 30 minutes a day can help lower chronic disease risk factors such as high blood pressure. Take a step to start or continue your journey to better health.

01

Install water-efficient plumbing fixtures (low-flow toilets, urinals, sinks and shower heads).

02.

Install faucet aerators – these mix water with air, creating a more misty spray and using less water than conventional faucets.

03

Rinse vegetables in a bowl and not under running water. Then, use that water to water your plants.

04.

Post a notice in your workplace kitchen, nudging people to use water wisely when washing the dishes.

05.

If you notice a leaky faucet, report it to your property manager.
