

PAPER REDUCTION

STOP AND THINK BEFORE YOU HIT THAT PRINT BUTTON! DO YOU KNOW HOW MANY SHEETS OF PAPER YOU PRINTED YESTERDAY?

On average, each North American uses 20,000 sheets of paper per year, or almost 55 sheets per day! This is roughly equivalent to one 15-foot tall pine tree per person. By reducing the amount of paper used at work we are preserving forests and reducing solid waste.

Saving paper also saves money. A recent study estimates that associated paper costs could be as much as 31 times the purchasing costs (not including labor). So, that ream of paper that your company paid \$5 for really could cost up to \$155!

USE YOUR BINS CORRECTLY.

KNOW WHAT CAN AND CANNOT BE RECYCLED IN YOUR WORKPLACE. IF YOU AREN'T SURE, CONTACT YOUR PROPERTY MANAGER.

REMEMBER...

RECYCLING IS A THREE-STEP PROCESS. COLLECTING USED MATERIALS IS THE IMPORTANT FIRST STEP. THE SECOND STEP INVOLVES USING THE MATERIALS IN THE MANUFACTURING OF NEW PRODUCTS. THE FINAL STEP IS PURCHASING AND USING RECYCLED PRODUCTS.



RECYCLE RIGHT

A LOT OF WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED AT WORK ENDS UP IN THE TRASH. RECYCLE RIGHT AT WORK BY MAKING SURE EVERYTHING GETS SORTED INTO ITS PROPER BIN.



Waste diversion is the percentage of total waste that is diverted from landfill through composting, reusing or recycling. In 2013, the average waste diversion rate across Bentall Kennedy office buildings was 43%. While above average, there is still a lot of room for improvement, as some office buildings have found it possible to achieve over 90 percent of waste being diverted into reuse or recycling!








DONATE IT! BEFORE DISCARDING

E-WASTE

WE ALL WANT THAT FANCY NEW SMARTPHONE! BUT EVER STOP TO THINK ABOUT HOW OUR DESIRE FOR THE LATEST AND GREATEST GADGETS IS IMPACTING THE ENVIRONMENT?

Electronic waste (e-waste) is one of the fastest growing waste streams in the world. 40 million metric tonnes of e-waste is produced each year. This would fill enough rail cars to circle the whole world!

According to some estimates, only 5-15% of this e-waste is actually recycled responsibly. The rest of it is likely being stored, disposed of in landfills, or is in some cases illegally shipped overseas.



TAKE IT FURTHER!

Make it easier for your coworkers to recycle their old electronics. Organize an e-waste drive at your workplace and schedule a pick-up from a responsible collector.

Check with your property manager, as they may already conduct regular pick-ups.
